Dale's Success Story


Dale came to Capri Gardens after undergoing a toe amputation secondary to diabetes. Prior to his surgery, Dale was living at home with his wife. He was very determined to return home!

Upon evaluation following his surgery, Dale was non weightbearing for transfers and moderate assist for bed mobility. He was unable to ambulate or attempt stairs, and demonstrated decreased activity tolerance. With hard work and motivation, Dale was able to return to his prior level of functional mobility during his activities of daily living, ambulating upwards of 300 feet with a front wheeled walker and using the stairs with only stand by assistance.

Dale is now living independently

at home with his wife with the ability to visit his family at his leisure and fully enjoy his retirement.
